

Please complete the following steps to prepare for your upcoming **OMNIPOD 5 PUMP SCHOOL**.

1. Dexcom

You must have the Dexcom G6 or G7 app on a compatible smartphone.

NOTE: The Dexcom G6 or G7 receiver alone cannot be used as part of the Omnipod 5 System; you must have the G6 or G7 app on a phone.

2. Onboarding with Omnipod and create an Omnipod ID

You will receive a 'Complete Your Omnipod[®] 5 Onboarding Now' email from Insulet or you can go to: <https://www.omnipod.com/en-ca/setup/canada>.

It is important that the Omnipod 5 onboarding is completed prior to the Omnipod 5 product training.

- Create an Omnipod ID by following the link on the log-in screen.
- Record the Omnipod ID and password, you will need it to log into the Omnipod 5 Controller during training.
- Review and approve the consent screens where information on the processing of personal data is outlined.
- Omnipod 5 onboarding is complete when the confirmation message has been received by you.

3. Connecting to Glooko[®]

Glooko is the Omnipod 5 data management platform that enables you to see glucose and insulin data.

Go to: <https://join.glooko.com/> to create a Glooko account. Link it with your Omnipod ID. The Best Centre proconnect code is **cbd**.

You will need the following supplies for your Pump School Part 2 Appointment:

- Pump box including controller and pods
- Blood glucose meter and test strips (even if using a sensor)
- Blood ketone meter and test strips
- Insulin for your pump start appointment only

If you will be using Humalog U-200 insulin in your pump, you **MUST** bring the insulin to your pump start appointment. Humalog U200 insulin **ONLY** comes in a prefilled pen. If you have trouble obtaining it from your pharmacy, please contact your diabetes educator.
