

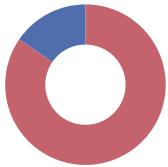

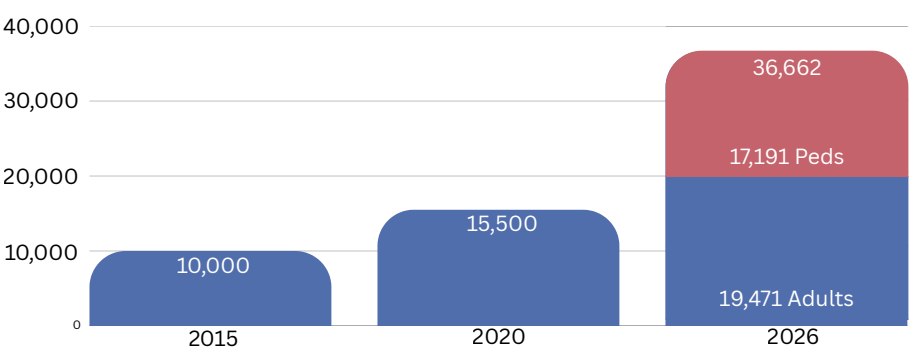

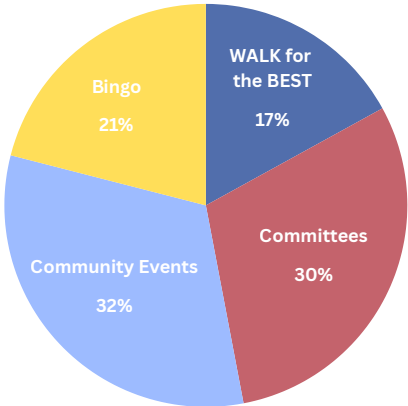

We’re raising \$11 million to expand and modernize our Centre for the next generation of T1D patients.

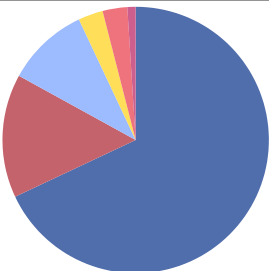
Progress
